Once again we are completely humbled and grateful for your support. Our Meatball Dinner was a huge success and definitely an event we will do again next year. We served over a 125 people! This was by far our best fundraiser, bringing in just under \$900! After a brief break we hosted our 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Variety market. I am kicking myself for not getting a picture of it, but the Fellowship hall was filled with your generosity in the form of donated rummage sale items. We had microwaves, furniture, name brand clothing, kitchen gadgets, toys, and even a chainsaw! The turnout was fantastic and much to our surprise our newly set record was broken! This event brought in over a \$1,000. We cannot thank you enough for all your support.

As June 3<sup>rd</sup> gets closer, we have really started doing our homework and trying to learn everything we can about the Pine Ridge Reservation and the Oglala Sioux. It's absolutely mind blowing to read the statistics and know this place isn't in some third world country but practically in our backyard. Many of the homes have no running water. The primary style of housing is trailers. In many cases, there is more than a dozen people living in a single wide trailer. The unemployment rate hovers in between 85-90%, the high school dropout rate is 70%, drug and alcohol abuse are extremely high, and the average life expectancy for males is 47 and females is 52. The stats are dizzying and depressing. If anything, it has fed our motivation and confirmed that this is exactly where God wants us to be. We cannot wait to get down there and get to work on improving the housing conditions. I hope you realize what an integral part you have all played in making this happen. Please keep the people of Pine Ridge in your prayers. Pray also for our youth. Pray that God makes their world bigger and that this experience motivates them and empowers them to do what they can for those less fortunate. We'll look forward to coming back and sharing our experience with all of you!

We are looking for a new summer concert adventure as the Life Light Festival is no longer continuing this year. We're looking at the Hills Alive Music Festival in Rapid City, SD and the Off the Charts Music Festival in Cavalier, ND. If you know of any other Christian Music festivals that you think our group would enjoy, please let us know!




