Here is a Psalm appropriate for the Easter season.

The LORD's Faithfulness Endures Forever

117 Praise the LORD, all nations! Extol him, all peoples!

For great is his steadfast love toward us, and the faithfulness of the LORD endures forever.

Praise the LORD!

It is the shortest Psalm in the Bible. Yet it's vision is unlimited. <u>All</u> peoples, <u>all</u> nations are to Praise the Lord. Why? Because of the Lord's steadfast love toward us and the fact that His faithfulness endures forever.

As we look throughout God's word we see that the Lord's faithfulness begins with Israel and then it expands even to us and to future generations. This happens through Christ. Christ's death on the cross for us and His resurrection – this is how the Lord shows us His steadfast love and faithfulness.
