so that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s.
 - ⁸ The LORD is merciful and gracious,
slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.
 - ⁹ He will not always chide,
nor will he keep his anger forever.
 - ¹⁰ He does not deal with us according to our sins,
nor repay us according to our iniquities.
 - ¹¹ For as high as the heavens are above the earth,
so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him;
 - ¹² as far as the east is from the west,
so far does he remove our transgressions from us.

Of the Psalms that I have memorized, Psalm 103 is one of my favorites. Because of space, I have not included all of the verses, so I would recommend reading the whole Psalm.

We are to “Bless the Lord”. What does it mean to bless the Lord? One writer has said that “It means to speak well of his greatness and goodness — and really mean it from the depths of your soul.” What has the Lord done that we should bless Him? This Psalm has quite a list: “forgives all your iniquity, heals diseases, redeems life. The Lord brings about justice for the oppressed. Part of the Psalm that speaks to forgiveness is verses 8 – 12. The Lord is slow to anger, abounding in steadfast love. The Lord removes our sins from us “as far as the east is from the west.” His steadfast love to us is as “high as the heavens are above the earth.” The Lord’s love for us and His forgiveness for all of our sins are reason enough to “speak well of God’s greatness and goodness.”

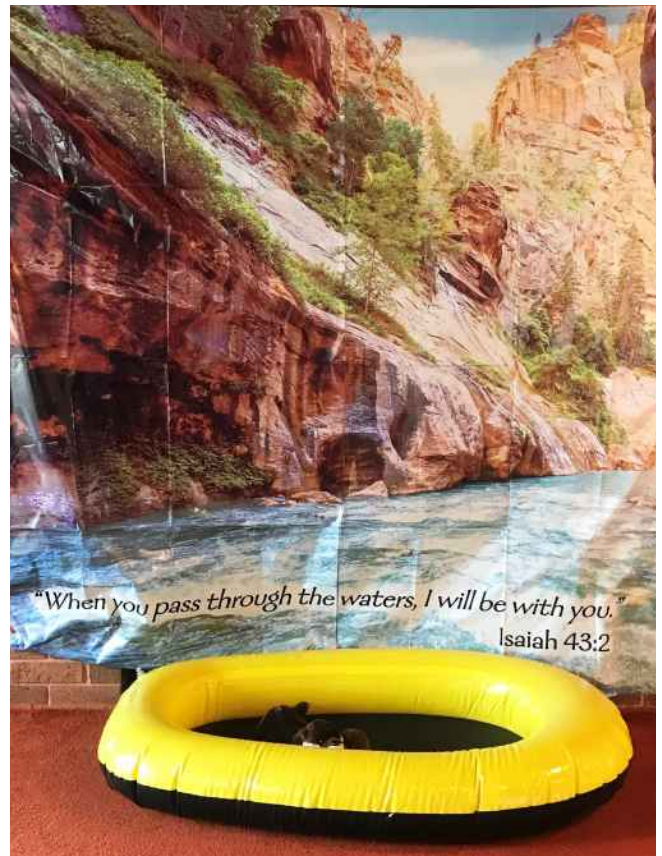
Psalm 103 begins and ends with the phrase. “Bless the Lord, O my soul! Let us join with the angels and all of creation in praising the Lord!
