During October we celebrate The Reformation, started by Martin Luther when he nailed the "Ninety-five Theses" to the door of the chapel in Wittenberg. We usually sing one of the hymns which Martin Luther wrote on Reformation Sunday – "A Mighty Fortress is our God." There is not room here for the whole hymn – but look it up – read the words. It is paraphrase of Psalm 46.

Psalm 46:10-11 says this: "Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth! "The Lord of hosts is with us; The God of Jacob is our fortress."

And so we sing "A mighty fortress is our God," The last stanza of the hymn goes like this: God's Word forever shall abide, no thanks to foes, who fear it; for God himself fights by our side with weapons of the Spirit. Were they to take our house, goods, honor, child, or spouse, though life be wrenched away, they cannot win the day. The kingdom's ours forever!



God's Word is what inspired Martin Luther to write those 95 Theses. God's Word is what will inspire us to trust our Lord be not only our "fortress" when times are getting tough, and God's word will also inspire us to trust our Lord to be our Savior. God's Word abides forever. God's Word tells us of God's love and forgiveness. Start a reformation in your life – Read God's Word!



**Kudos** to LeAnn Richard for volunteering to co-chair FLCW in 2019. She will be a wonderful addition to our board!



It seems (at least to some) that our storms and hurricanes and weather in general is getting worse! This may or may not be depending on your views on global warming or cooling or whatever. I'm not even sure where I stand on the issue of today's weather changes and global climate. It's also amazing to me how many states immediately send many of their own trained volunteers, North Dakota being no exception to this, sending our own Red Cross and disaster trained volunteers as quickly as possible to help out. How people recover from these events is a mystery to me, but here's what I do know ... when it comes to disaster stewardship, God has it handled! God always provides the men, women and even children to let these people know they are not alone and that there is help for them in their distress. Please don't forget to do your part by donating whatever you can afford to any of the many volunteer organizations that are involved in the relief efforts, just be sure to check them out first to see that they are a good and viable organization. Believe me, every dollar will be appreciated and put to good use. Stewardship? 'Ya betcha! God bless them all!
