One of the Gospel readings in February is from Luke 5:1-11. I hope you will take time to read it. This is the story of Jesus calling Simon, James and John as His disciples. Jesus is speaking to a crowd by lake Gennesaret. The crowd was pressing in on Him so He gets into one of the boats of a fisherman by the name of Simon.

After Jesus is done speaking He tells Simon to go into the deep water and let down the nets for a catch. Simon was reluctant to do so because they had been fishing all night and had not caught anything. Yet Simon says, "But at your word I will let down the nets." You might remember that when they did they caught so many fish that the nets were beginning to break. With the help of his partners they filled two boats so full they were beginning to sink.



"At your word." What might happen in our lives and in our ministry as God's people either individually or as a congregation if we would say that. "Lord, at your word ...." The statement assumes that we have actually heard what our Lord wants us to do. That in turn means that we have spent time in the study of God's word and in prayer so that we know what our Lord wants us to do. Maybe what the Lord wants us to do is what we have been doing with seemingly no results. Or maybe what the Lord wants us to do is something new, that we have never thought of and probably would not think of doing without some prompting. "At Your Word" Lord, we will do what You ask of us. Think of the possibilities!

Our Lord calls us as His disciples, to follow Him, to be about the task of "catching people," to be about doing what He calls us to do.
