CALL COMMITTEE REPORT

Matt Gardner – Call Committee Co-Chair

Your Call Committee has been working hard over the last several months laying down solid groundwork towards the call for a new pastor. Finding a new pastor is something the Committee is taking very seriously. It is important to the Committee that this is a Christ led process that involves the congregation.

Along with the work of the Committee, the congregation is also playing an important part in the call process. Although the Committee selected by the congregation is a diverse group, it is important to hear the voice of the congregation. In order to get input from the congregation on the future of the church, the call committee developed and initiated a survey. The survey went out to around 360 church member households through the newsletter, were given to Sunday school students to take home and were also available in the church. With your strong participation we have statistically accurate survey results, with a confidence level of 95%, to use in our search for a new pastor.

The next step for the Committee is to use the information collected from the survey and other congregational information to complete a congregational profile. The congregational profile will be sent to the North American Lutheran Church (NALC) and the Lutheran Congregations in Mission for Christ (LCMC) to be posted on their respective websites. Once posted, prospective Pastors will be able to learn about First Lutheran, decide if this is where God is calling them to serve and reach out to the call committee. Our goal is to have the congregational profiles complete and posted before the Annual Meeting on January 19.

Thank you for your participation in the survey and support of this important step for our Church.
