## FIRST LUTHERAN CHURCH UPDATES REGARDING THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC!

As of the June 3 council meeting the following decisions were made  
regarding the Coronavirus Pandemic (Next meeting is July 1):

- First Lutheran will begin in person worship services as of June 14 limiting to a total of 150 people.
- Masks are recommended but not required.
- Pews will be blocked off.
- Hymn books, pew cards and pencils will be removed.
- Bulletins will be put in the pews.
- Singing will be limited.
- Holy Communion will be done with one aisle station from one side of the church then going to the other side.
- CDC guidelines on the Smart Restart will be followed.
- Offering plates will not be passed but will be on the bulletin table for you to put your offering in before or after worship.
- We will also continue with Facebook Live services at least through June. (Due to unforeseen circumstances since the meeting, Facebook Live services have been suspended until further notice.)
- There will be no gathering downstairs with the exception of utilizing the restroom facilities.
- It was determined that AA will be the only group allowed to meet at this time.
- Watch the church website, Facebook and notices on the church doors for further updates.

- Coronavirus – discussion was held and the following decisions were made:

  - Offering plate will be on the bulletin table for offering instead of passing the offering plate
  - No gathering downstairs with the exception of utilizing the restroom facilities, and it was determined that AA will be the only group allowed to meet at this time
  - There will be no green or prayer request cards, if there are prayer requests they should be submitted to Jeannette by phone or email or let the ushers know
  - Front door only will be unlocked during the hours of 11 am – 2 pm Monday through Saturday and during Sunday church service



Wait patiently for the Lord.  
Be brave and courageous!  
Hope is trusting God to act in his good timing.  
Psalm 27:14

We are living in very trying times. I ran across some Bible verses on HOPE that seemed appropriate... Look them up and see if you agree.

So here's the question: What can I do when things seem hopeless?

How about 1 Samuel 1:1-28 - Hannah was in deep anguish, crying bitterly as she prayed to the Lord...

A Special Constituency Meeting was called to order June 14, 2020, at 3:05 pm at CCM. The purpose of this meeting was explained in a letter to constituent churches which also contained a ballot that could be completed by three delegates and one rostered leader from each church and returned prior to the June 14 meeting. "The motion to come before the constituency at the special meeting read: The Camp of the Cross Board of Directors moves to obtain a 10-year \$150,000 loan from Garrison State Bank and Trust to be used to finish the drain field and lift station at the Fellowship Center, using the Endowment Fund as collateral. Annual interest from the endowment fund will pay for the loan principal and any interest accrued during this 10-year loan period." Sixty-four delegates via the postcard ballot responded "yes", six responded "no". The attendees at the meeting from five churches (total of 7 people) also gave approval. Following the vote, the attendees talked about the beauty of the grounds, the new wooden quilt wall in the Fellowship Center, and the excellent landscaping, clear signage, and much needed gravel addition to the roads. Administration was complimented for the efforts, which they said would be passed on to staff and contractors. Drain field construction should begin before the end of the month and may take three weeks to complete, Executive Director Janis Sloka said.

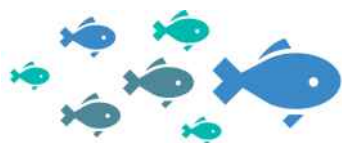
