FIRST LUTHERAN CHURCH UPDATES REGARDING THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC!

As of the September 2, 2020 council meeting the following decisions were made regarding the Coronavirus Pandemic (Next meeting is October 8):

- ⇒ First Lutheran will keep maintaining worship services as is, limiting up to a total of 150 people. Face masks are strongly encouraged but not required. Bring your own mask, if you don't, masks will be available for your use. As of now Facebook Live services will continue.
- ⇒ It was determined that small groups of no more than 24 people are the only groups allowed to meet at the church at this time with the exception of Sunday School and Pastor Ordination reception. No food to be prepared in the kitchen at this time and no coffee hour. Please make sure to have your group scheduled through the church office.
- \Rightarrow Doors will be open daily from 9:00 am 3:00 pm.
- \Rightarrow Watch the church website <u>www.flcwashburn.com</u> and Facebook for further updates.
- ⇒ We ask that you remember your tithing for the church. Either send your payment to the church or drop it off at Farmers Security Bank in Washburn notating it is a donation for First Lutheran Church if you will not be attending worship at the church.

Was decided that picking out paint color, painting and picking new drapes would wait until Mann's got here so they could help decide.
- Things already done at the parsonage:
 - Carpet cleaned
 - Concrete cut out but not poured by garage door.
 - Moisture issue taken care of by the planter box.
 - Some lights in basement furnace room changed.
 - Deck stained
- Aaron will fix the dryer vent.
- Looking at taking carpet off front steps and possibly painting.
- Other updates will be done as time permits and money budgeted.
- Handicap entry in church basement has a leak when it rains. Looking at ways to get on the roof to fix.

SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING AUGUST 30, 2020

- President Kris Schmidt called the meeting to order.
- Kris thanked the Call Committee for their work done and commented on Charles Mann. He then stated the purpose of the meeting is to vote by written ballot to approve placing a Letter of Call to candidate Charles Mann. If approved, a second vote by sign to approve the salary and compensation to be included in the Letter of Call will be called for with approval required by a simple majority.
- Confirmed the 67 registered voting members present met the quorum requirements. Would need a 45 person "yes" vote to pass.

- Matt Gardner thanked Pastor Curt Hanson, the congregation and Call Committee members: Wendy Miller – Co-chair, Lexie Solomonson, Cassidy Sommer, Kathy Keller, Elmer Schwarz, Donna Gunderson, Arden Wagner, Hannah Westrick, Sue Winter, Jeff Schmidt and Shenille Lillejord along with Jeannette Rost.
- Matt stated they did three virtual interviews and two in person interviews and had two possible candidates come to Washburn and lead a worship service. The Call Committee unanimously committed to call Charles Mann.
- Matt also stated that Charles Mann's coaches at Seminary would like to be here for his Ordination, which could possibly be the first Sunday of October.
- Kris called for a vote by ballot for a Letter of Call to Charles Mann. There was a 100% "yes" vote.
- Matt then went over the Pastoral Compensation and Benefits that was passed out before the meeting.
- Aaron Vorland moved and Gwen Hall 2nd to approve the draft of Explanation of Compensation and Benefits as presented. Motion carries.

I must say THANK YOU once again to our teachers. All our classes are covered and we have lots of parents who have volunteered to pop in and help out our teachers.


Fall Activities






