Born Again to a Living Hope



³ "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead" ~ 1 Peter 1:3 (ESV)

Happy Easter season to everyone! It has been such a blessed time for our church to walk towards some more normal rhythms of life and ministry as we celebrated the start of the season of Easter those few weeks ago. There has been much activity in many of the different ministries through the Lenten season. As we reach the close of this school year, we will celebrate many milestones in the life of the church.

It has been wonderful to see a number of baptisms being celebrated this new year, and the First Communion of 11 young people just to name a few. We also had a successful new ministry opportunity of the 7-week "The Marriage Course," in which 8 couples participated. The amazing thing was that the range of years married was from 5 years to 60 years. We hope to have many more opportunities like this in the future. It was an excellent example that we can continue to grow in our marriage relationships no matter how long you have been married.

The verse above is from the 1st letter of Peter, and as a whole, it is a letter of encouragement. The opening of this letter we begin to hear a key theme that permeates the entire letter, which here we hear of the themes of suffering and hope that come together. Our verse above shows the connection that God is being acknowledged as the Father of Jesus. Those who face distress and suffering, as God's chosen, are provided a "new birth" and "living hope." This is the new life and birth that we all share and is based on the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Hope is possible because even in the direst situations and tribulation this living hope gives us life to continue on.

This reminds us in our baptism we enter into this new life of faith. We are reminded in Paul's letter to the Romans, ⁴ "We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life." (Romans 6:4). Peter's letter continues to spell out this hope that Christians have, in verses 4-5 "⁴ to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, ⁵ who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time." Through Jesus Christ, we now have a living hope and know the promise of God that we will live in Him forever. What we continue to do as we walk together in faith is to rejoice, so we may face any trial or challenge knowing we are in the safely care of Jesus.

There are many milestones and events that are planned for the month of May in the life of the church. We will have 7 confirmands affirming

First Lutheran Church live streaming service will switch from Facebook Live to YouTube Live in early June. Those who currently use Facebook to watch our services will not see any interruption in being able to view through Facebook. We are doing this to remove any barriers for people looking to connect with our worship services. In most cases using Facebook for the streaming service requires individuals to have a Facebook account to view the services. Utilizing YouTube will not require an account for anyone to watch our worship services. YouTube will also archive our live services to be viewed later and for any future historical needs by the church. We will post the YouTube link on Facebook for easy reference for people who are accustomed to finding the service there. We will also provide instructions for finding the First Lutheran YouTube site. This transition will allow First Lutheran Church to connect more people with God's Word. Stay Tuned to our Facebook feed and website for further updates.

APRIL 13, 2021 COUNCIL MEETING



(Please note that minutes are not approved until voted on by the council at the next meeting.)

The Church Council met on April 13, 2021, at 7:00 PM. Present were: Matt Gardner, Melanie Beckman, Donna Sommer, Kathy Keller, Jeff Schmidt, Mac Beaudry, Pastor Mann, Janet Hanson, Jeannette Rost, Administrative Secretary, Mike Aull, and Judy Beaudry. Absent were: Stacy Boeshans and Aaron Vorland.

The meeting was called to order.

Pastor led with devotions based on Matthew 28:16 -20. We are to go out and be disciples of all nations.

Judy Beaudry and Mike Aull were there to discuss Super Sunday Supper. They would like to start on May 23. Schmidt/Beckman to approve a startup amount of \$100.00 for this group. Money will come from the Easter Breakfast money and if more is needed, it will come from the Evangelism budget. Carried.

Beckman/Sommer to approve the minutes from March 9, 2021. Carried.

Sommer gave the treasurer's report. The following balances are on hand: CD's: \$150,000.00; Checking: \$87,985.65; Building: \$49,023.99; Cemetery: \$617.40; Interest: \$5,360.60; Music: \$902.81; Parking Lot: \$955.00; Worship: \$3,956.89; Morgan Stanley: \$11,992.40. Total Assets: \$310,794.74. Keller/Schmidt to approve the report for future audit and to pay all non-budgeted bills. Carried.

Pastors Report: On Maundy Thursday, there were 11 young people taking their first communion. He held a baptism for Mavrey Carlson and Sophia and Bradley Hanson. He has met with staff and members, had eight other member visits, had 14 visits/ phone visits, and six attempted, and had two in person/home communions. He would like to start a Deacon program where we would have members of the congregation become deacons who could meet and check in with shut-ins and help with other visitation to help Pastor. There will be more study on this and discuss it at a later time.

Review of the constitution: Schmidt went over the duties of the Worship Deacon.

Committee reports:

Stewardship: Keller-Will be sending thank you's to the ones giving Thrivent dollars.

Worship: Schmidt-reported he has received good feedback on scheduling of the readers/communion helpers.

Education: Rost reported for Boeshans. On April 25, all students will be active in the service. The Sunday School is working with the women to collect items for LWR kits. The class who collects the most will get pie with the Pastor. May 9 is the last day of Sunday School. They would like to have the Sunday School students treat their mom's after Church in the Fellowship hall. VBS will be held June 1-4 for both the preschool and Elementary age students.

Evangelism: Beckman-she is looking for prayer warriors for the seniors.

Property: Vorland was absent, so Pastor reported that the windows are on order and they are looking at installation the beginning of August. They are looking at the church storage and what is being stored at the church and which organizations. We need to look at what groups have items stored and reorganize and sort it out.

Technology: Pastor went over a Facebook policy they put together. Beckman/Hanson to accept the Facebook policy. Carried. Discussion was held that we need to start a policy book so all the policies the Church has can be in one book.

There was a consensus of the council to shift from Facebook to YouTube Live with a link on FB for services. This will hopefully start the middle/end of May.

Old Business:

We have members that have agreed to be on the Endowment committee.

We have made a down payment on the security system.

Beaudry and Gardner are working on the Mutual Ministry committee.

Dedication ceremony will be on May 16 for the pew cushions, roof, parking lot, video system & screen,

and other items purchased lately. We will have coffee, juice, and cupcakes after church.

The hearing assist system has been ordered and they will be here on April 20 to give a demonstration.

Covid related restrictions were discussed. Beaudry/Sommer to remove the capacity limit and to resume snacks with coffee at fellowship starting May 9. Carried.

Sommer/Keller to approve the following transfers in: Eric, Sara and Alexis Rosenquist, and Melissa Rothe. Carried.

The next meeting will be on Thursday, May 13, 2021 at 7:00 pm.

Beckman/Keller to adjourn. Carried.

We ended with the Lord's Prayer.




Sunday School
