Blessed greetings to all of you. We find ourselves at the start of the liturgical season of Pentecost in the church year. The first half of the church year the focus is on Jesus' birth, life, death, resurrection and ascension (Advent through Easter). Pentecost is the longest season of the church year and the focus shifts to the community of faith and believers. This season is filled with the key themes of the Holy Spirit, witness, growth and discipleship.

This season is also marked by the color green and reminds us of growth. So, a key question to ask is to check where am I currently at in my faith journey? The above quote from Holy Scripture is from the gospel of Luke. There are two parts: 1) Loving God and 2) Loving your neighbor as yourself. Not only are we to love God, but we are to do it in an all-encompassing way. Notice the *with all* your HEART (innermost being), *with all* your SOUL (what gives us our individual identity), *with all* your STRENGTH (energy, strength, resolve and resources), *with all* your MIND (understanding and intellectual capacities). We cannot withhold any part of our lives from God.

How can we figure out summer? Rest is of course needed, but it is summer that brings to us a challenge to find new rhythms of everyday life. But there may also be a need to find different rhythms for our spiritual journey as well. The question becomes, are we being intentional and consistent in our engagement with God? Is our awareness of God's love and presence growing in our lives? Are we taking time to grow in knowledge and grace of God or in reflecting on and applying scripture to our everyday lives? Are we worshipping God in spirit and in truth?

There are many ways to stay plugged into our faith and our church community during the summer. Worship will continue throughout the summer at the church as will the online offering of the services. It may be even possible for you to try a new spiritual discipline or bible study to add during this time. Maybe during vacation, you can have a family devotion or bible study. If you would like help finding materials we would love to help and equip you for your continued journey with Jesus this summer.

May the Holy Spirit, continue to sustain and grow your faith in Jesus.

MAY 13, 2021

COUNCIL MEETING

(Please note that minutes are not approved until voted on by the council at the next meeting.)



The Church Council met on May 13, 2021, at 7:00 PM. Present were: Matt Gardner, Melanie Beckman, Donna Sommer, Jeff Schmidt, Mac Beaudry, Pastor Mann, Stacy Boeshans, and Janet Hanson. Absent were: Kathy Keller and Aaron Vorland.

The meeting was called to order.

Pastor led with devotions on Spiritual responsiveness and listening to the Holy Spirit and taking action according to what we are hearing. Key verses are Proverbs 3:5-6, Galatians 5:25, and James 1:22.

Sommer/Beckman to approve the minutes from April 13, 2021. Carried.

Sommer gave the treasurer's report. The following balances are on hand: CD's: \$150,000.00; Checking: \$90,056.52; Building: \$49,073.99; Cemetery: \$617.40; Interest: \$5,360.60; Music: \$1,162.81; Parking Lot: \$1,060.00; Worship: \$4,532.39; Morgan Stanley: \$11,992.40. Total Assets: \$313,856.11. Schmidt/Beckman to approve the report for future audit and to pay all non-budgeted bills. Carried.

Pastors Report: Pastor presided over one funeral service and a committal service, and we had confirmation on May 2 for 7 young people. He has been meeting with staff and members along with visits/phone visits and in person home communion. He is still working on the Deacon program, thinking of having a fun with the youth where the youth can better get to know Pastor and Steph. We are looking at having a Honey Service in the fall with Paul Krueger coming possibly the first Sunday in Oct.

Review of the constitution: Gardner and Pastor went over the duties of the Stewardship Deacon in the absence of Keller.

Committee reports:

Worship: Schmidt reported he has talked with the pianists, music leaders, and altar to let them know he is an advocate for them and if they have any concerns, they are to come to him. He is checking with members to see what their vision of service is and what changes they would like to see.

Education: Sunday school is done for the year. They had a great year. Planning is taking place for VBS.

Evangelism: Beckman-she has found prayer warriors for the seniors, and wants to know if we will be putting hymnals/communion forms out anytime soon. This led to when/if we want to change any of our covid practices. Beaudry/Boeshans to resume service and practices to pre-covid practices starting June 6. Carried.

Property: Vorland was absent, so Pastor reported they received a proposal on the bathroom remodel. They are going to check on a few more details before approving anything. There is an electrical issue in Rost's office and Weber will come to check on it. The parking lot still needs to be sealed and lined. The council was informed that Vorland will be moving, so we will need to find a new Property Deacon. Gardner will contact the nominating committee to meet.

Technology: YouTube live will be up by the end of June.

Old Business:

Members of the Endowment committee will have their first meeting in June. Installation on the security system will be next week. Dedication ceremony will be on May 16 for the pew cushions, roof, parking lot, video system & screen, and other items purchased lately. We will have coffee, juice, and cupcakes after church. Keller has been working on this. Some people have been trying the hearing assist system. Hopefully more can try it out.

New Business:

The LCMC Annual Gathering & Convention is Oct. 3-6. Pastor would like to attend. We will try to find other members to attend as voting delegates. Riverboat Days are in June. Beckman/Beaudry to have a float in the Riverboat Days parade and to include a budget of \$250.00 and to use Thrivent Choice Dollars (either what we have on hand or with a Thrivent card). Carried. Beckman will get candy/trinkets and Beaudry will find a driver for the float.

Beaudry brought to the council a request from Peggy Moran to host a Sunday worship meal at Camp of the Cross. Beaudry/Schmidt to support Camp of the Cross Sunday worship meal for \$500.00.

Beckman/Schmidt to approve the following transfers out: Rani Schmidt to Peace Lutheran Church of Hazen, and Charley Beaudry to Hope Church of Grand Forks.

The next meeting will be on Wednesday, June 9, 2021 at 7:00 pm.

Every family is encouraged to attend church or other activities in the manner that they feel most comfortable (whether on-line or in person).



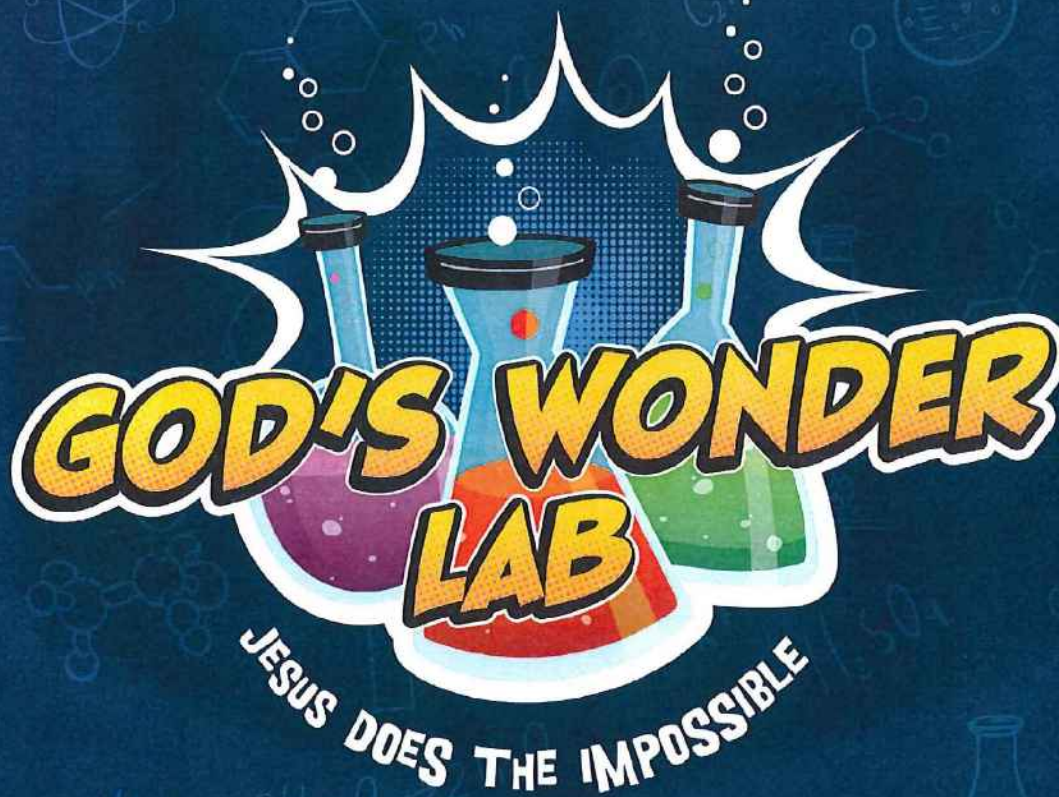

Summer Marriage Course?

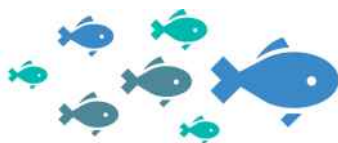

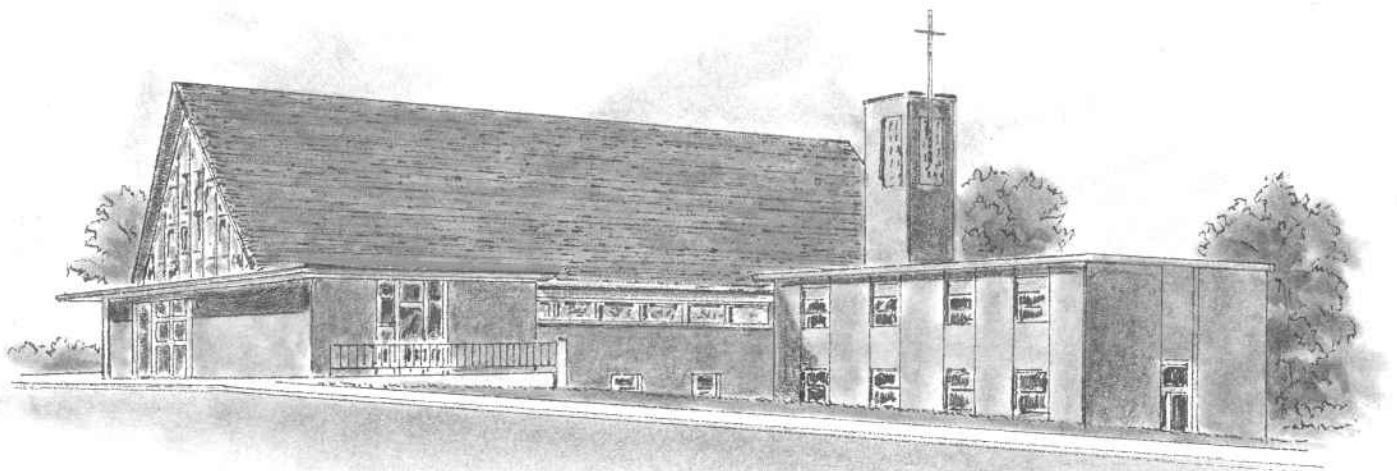
