Ephesians 6:18

Blessings to you as we round the homestretch of summer and begin to shift gears back to our fall routines. I hope you have been able to use your time this summer to be with those you hold dear and especially taking this change in routine to explore your faith journey in new ways. We have been looking at some exciting things coming up this fall, with Sunday School coming back in September and other returning ministries. We will have many opportunities for you to invest in your faith walk with Jesus and invest in the next generation of First Lutheran Church. We are so blessed by God with who He has given us to do ministry with together, each of you!

The above verse helps us see into the full world of the Ephesians... to what Paul is exhorting his readers to do. Chapter 6 is the final chapter of Ephesians, and this verse comes after when Paul is describing how they are to be armed with the power of God (full armor of God; vv. 10-17). Our verse follows this section by returning the focus to where the letter began, to the theme of prayer. We see how prayer is necessary to the life of faith and is an example by the end of Ephesians of a mature disciple of Jesus Christ.

As I've reflected on this August newsletter, many things came to mind over our first year at FLC. I recalled in my first newsletter article a call for the congregation to praise God with thanksgiving for all his gifts and especially to join together in prayer over the future ministry at FLC. So today I would like to do this again and join together in a call to prayer for the future ministry. However, I would like us to include a call to pray for our spiritual lives and reflect on our relationship with Jesus. This will be helped by a slight addition to this request.

This fall, we will be exploring the life of prayer as a key indicator in the spiritual life and finding more and maybe new ways for each of us to engage in prayer for each other. Knowing the great sacrifice our military members make for each of us Americans, I would like to first call us to pray specifically for our military members (those who are members of the congregation and friends of the congregation)~~We will be putting more information out in the bulletins (especially by the September newsletter) for exactly how this will work. The idea is to have an up-to-date list of our brothers & sisters in arms that we will publish each week in the bulletin next to the weekly prayer list that the congregation is actively praying for. We remember the sacrifice of our Lord Jesus, and how he was always focused on another than himself even in his most

mation ministry at First Lutheran. These changes are taking into account the feedback we received from our confirmands last year as well as other changes that we thought will enhance


coming fall.






